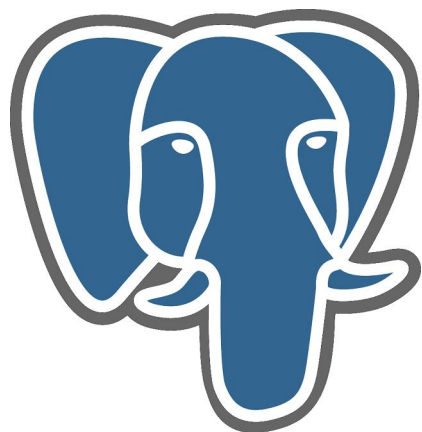


PGCon 2009
