Bad Code Is Like Swearing Around Children

Some of your code is bad,

and you should feel bad.

Like this:

-- file universal orm.sql
production database# Create Table
Entity Value (
    Entity text NOT NULL,
    Value text NOT NULL
Comment On Table Entity Value is 'we can decompose any
object with this!';
```

Or this:

-- file update_enrollment.sql

```

Or This:

        vield id
```

Dead Code Just wastes your time... ...compiling ...refactoring ...unit tests ...confusing the young'uns

Part of the python 2->3 upgrade...

def seemingly_important_function():
    # critical infrastructure
    print 'critical infrastructure'
    while unit_of_work = module.get_work():
        submit_work(unit_of_work)
```

Ways To Make It Better

Don't Comment Out Unused Code

Delete It.

Clean up after yourself:
